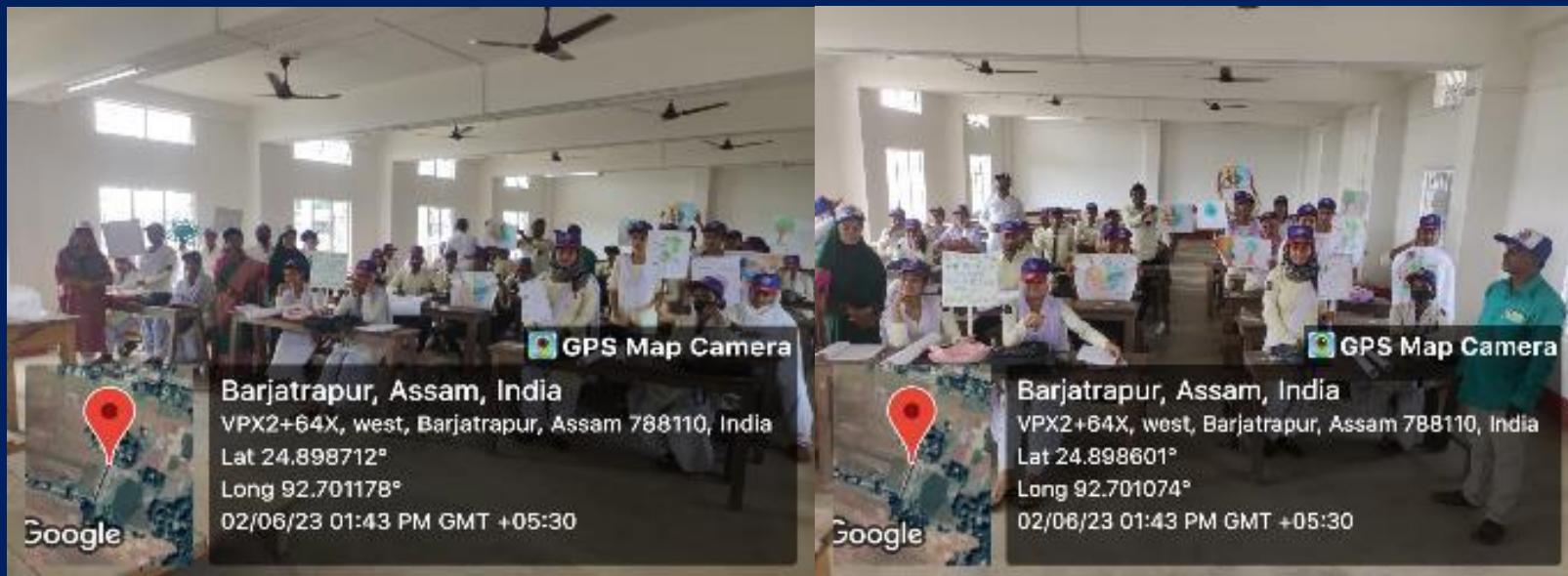

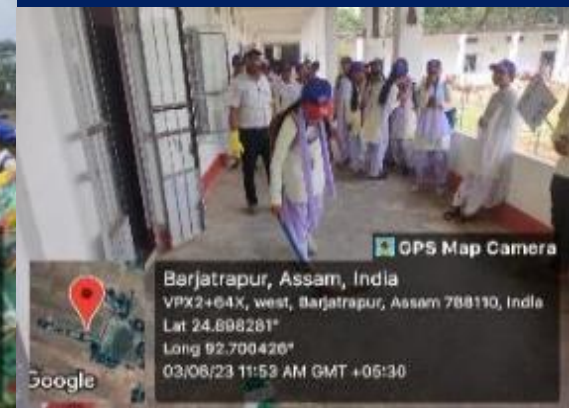


## Swachhta Hi Seva Campaign, west Silchar College,

On 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2023,

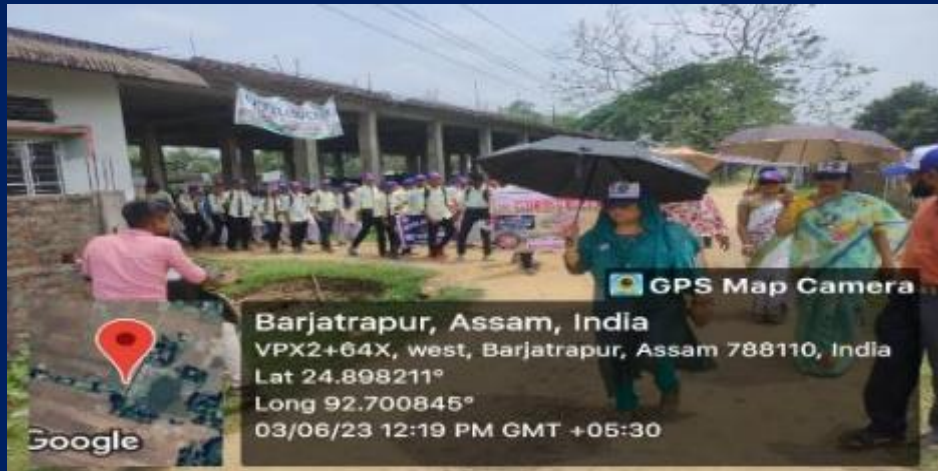

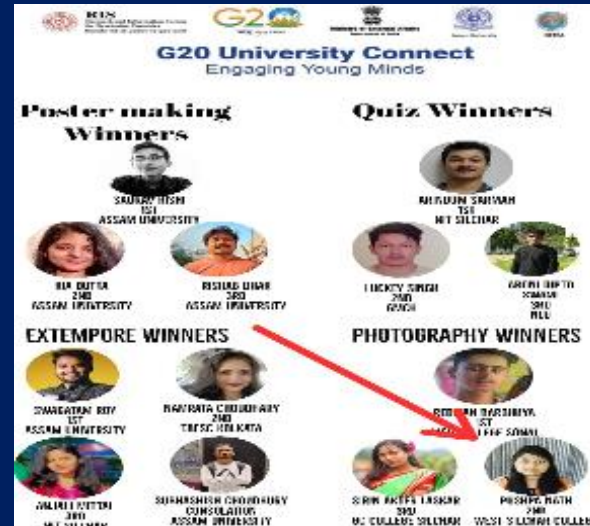

He played 185 matches and scored more than 400 goals. He was also awarded the Padma Bhushan, India's third-highest civilian award, in 1956.
